



# Chincoteague Cultural Alliance

## Directions to Chincoteague

*From Delaware Memorial Bridge – New Castle, DE Area*

*Approximately 3 hours from New Castle, DE to Chincoteague Island, VA*

- On the Delaware side of the bridge follow the signs to Rt. 13 South. US-13 S becomes DE-1 S. Travel about 35 miles.
- Merge onto US-13 S via EXIT 97 toward SALISBURY/NORFOLK (Crossing into MARYLAND). Travel about 54 miles.
- At Salisbury take the by-pass. Exit right just past all the shopping malls. Get in the left lane of the exit ramp. *Do not bear right toward Cambridge.* Stay left and head toward Ocean City and Norfolk. If you miss the turn, just stay on Rt. 13. You'll get to the same place. But you get to enjoy all the traffic lights and shopping malls along the way.
- The bypass becomes Rt. 13. Stay on the main road. ***DO NOT*** exit onto Rt. 50 toward Ocean City. Keep going south on Rt. 13.
- Cross the Maryland – Virginia line just beyond Pocomoke City. It's about five miles to the next turn from the border.
- Pass the Virginia Visitors Center on the right
- Pass through the town of New Church – truck scales there
- At Route 175 turn left. There is a traffic light – the first one after the MD/VA boarder. If you pass the Food Lion Grocery Store and Sonics fast food place on the left you missed the turn. If you enter the village of Oak Hall you missed the turn.
- Follow Rt. 175 about 15 miles and you will be on Chincoteague Island. Along the way you'll pass through NASA Wallops Island Flight Facility and see the visitors center with its rockets on the right. You'll travel the four mile causeway to cross Chincoteague Bay.
- At the traffic light after you cross the drawbridge you'll be at the intersection of Main Street and Maddox Blvd. Now follow the specific directions to the venue in which you'll perform or demonstrate.
